

Please familiarize yourself with the following steps to take during an urgent need to evacuate the 2020 and T106 modular buildings.

In the event a fire alarm sounds or a Tornado Warning is issued, all building occupants should immediately evacuate the 2020 and T106 modular buildings:

- Take only essential personal items (cell phone, ID, keys, medications, wallet, and purse.)
- Move quickly, but in an orderly manner out of the building. **DO NOT PUSH OR SHOVE.**
- If the corridor is filled with smoke, stay low and crawl out.
- If requested, accompany and assist persons with disabilities.
- Once out of the building, seek immediate shelter in the *Cancer and Genetics Research Complex auditorium*, located in room 101 of the north wing as shown on the map below.
- **DO NOT** seek shelter in your vehicle.
- **DO NOT** leave the premises until all occupants are accounted for. Remain in the auditorium until receiving an appropriate “all clear” notification by University or public safety officials.
